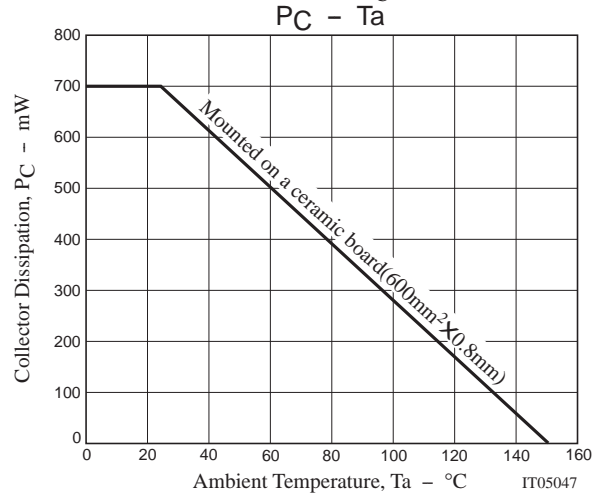
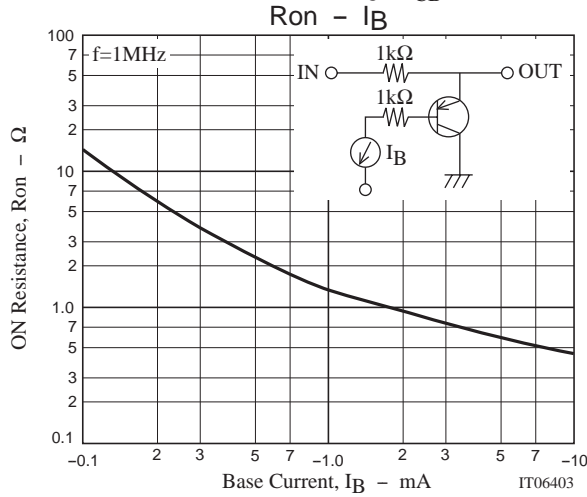
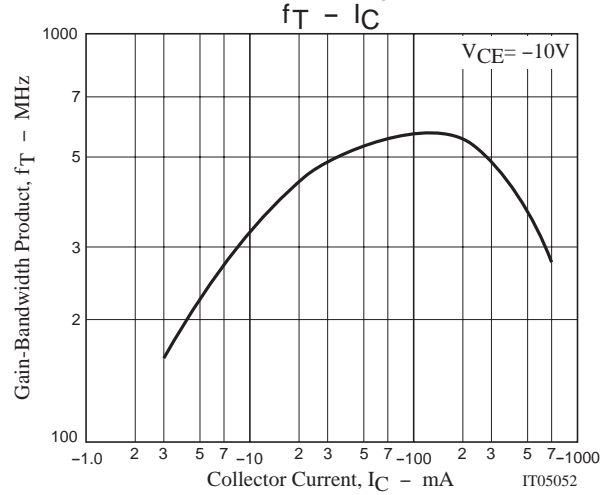
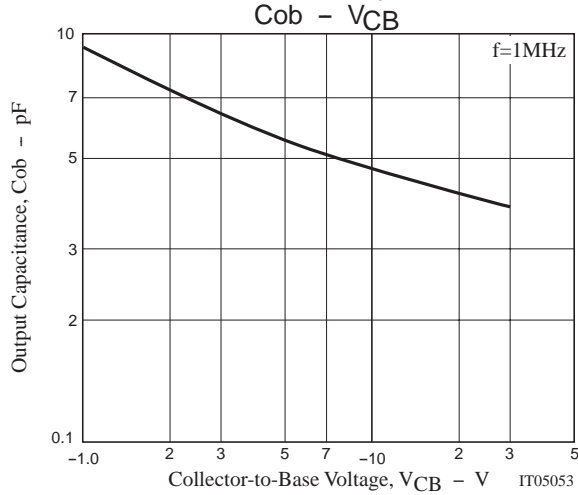
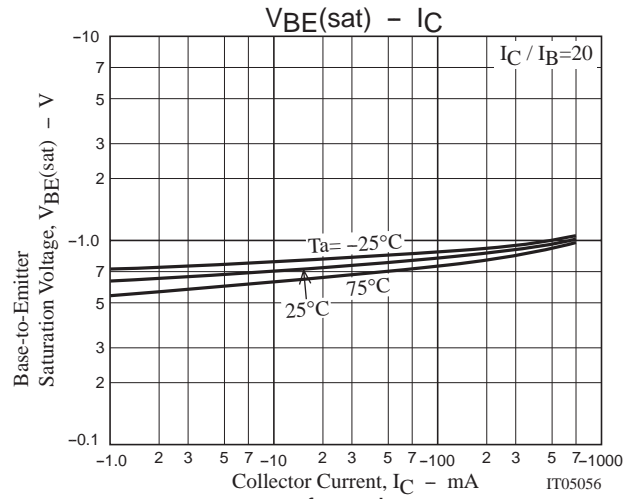
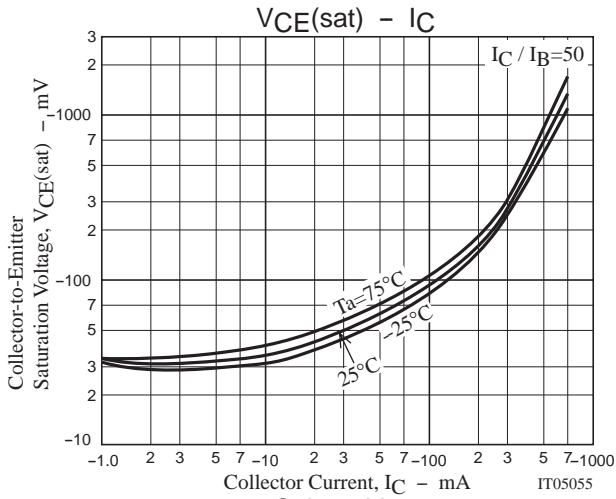
Switching Time Test Circuit
