#### Features

- Built-in bias resistors enable the configuration of an inverter circuit without connecting external input resistors (see equivalent circuit).
- 2)The bias resistors consist of thin-film resistors with complete isolation to allow negative biasing of the input.
- They also have the advantage of almost completely eliminating parasitic effects.
- 3)Only the on / off conditions need to be set for operation, making the device design easy.

NPN epitaxial planar silicon transistor (Resistor built-in type)








Fig.1 Input voltage vs. output current (ON characteristics)




Fig.2 Output current vs. input voltage (OFF characteristics)




Fig.3 DC current gain vs. output current




Fig.4 Output voltage vs. output current

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
